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# Leelee Knits

 Knitting and Crochet

## Supplies/Materials:

Here is what you will need to make this baby blanket:

- US 9/5.5 mm Straight Knitting Needles (14" long).
- 4 Skeins of [Knit Picks Mighty Stitch](#) yarn in Blush.
- Scissors.
- Tapestry/Yarn needle to weave in ends.

## Finished Size:

This blanket measures: 26" wide X 30" long.

## Gauge:

4.25 stitches, 5 rows = 1 Inch in stockinette stitch.

## Abbreviations:

K	Knit
P	Purl

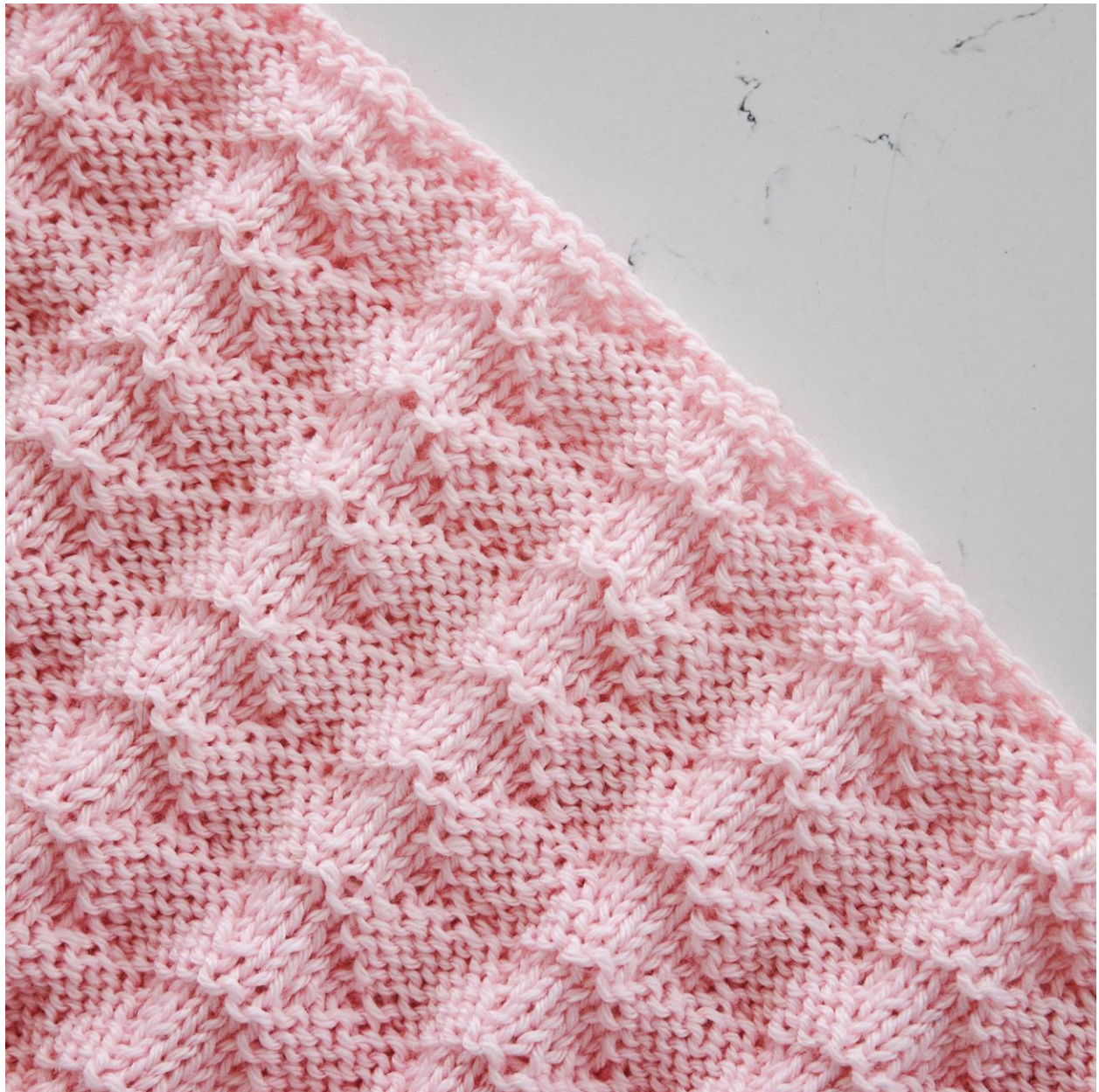
# Leelee Knits

*Knitting and Crochet*

## Pattern:

Cast on 121 stitches.

Knit two rows for bottom border in garter stitch (knit all stitches for both rows). Continue to Body of Blanket.



# Leelee Knits

 Knitting and Crochet

## **Body of Blanket:**

Row 1: K6, \*P1, K8; repeat from \* to last 7 stitches, P1, K6.

Row 2: K2, P3, \*K3, P6; repeat from \* to last 8 stitches, K3, P3, K2.

Row 3: K4, \*P5, K4; repeat from \* end of row.

Row 4: K2, P1, \*K7, P2; repeat from \* to last 10 stitches, K7, P1, K2.

Row 5: K2, Purl to last 2 stitches, K2.

Row 6: K2, P1, \*K7, P2; repeat from \* to last 10 stitches, K7, P1, K2 (same as row 4).

Row 7: K4, \*P5, K4; repeat from \* end of row (same as row 3).

Row 8: K2, P3, \*K3, P6; repeat from \* to last 8 stitches, K3, P3, K2 (same as row 2).

Repeat rows 1-8 until blanket measures just under 30 inches. Knit two more rows in garter stitch for top border.

Cast off and weave in ends.

Wet block the blanket to flatten out the stitches and lengthen it to its final measurement of 26" wide X 30" long. If you are not familiar with wet blocking, refer to the following article on the Leelee Knits blog on how to wet block your knitting:

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# Leelee Knits

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## Supplies/Materials:

Here is what you will need to make this baby blanket:

- US 10.5/6.5 mm Straight Knitting Needles (14" long).
- [Paintbox Yarns Simply Aran Yarn](#)
  - 2 Skeins Duck Egg Blue Color A
  - 2 Skeins Misty Grey Color B
- Scissors.
- Tapestry/Yarn needle to weave in ends.

## Finished Size:

This blanket measures: 23.5" wide X 40" long.

## Gauge:

4 stitches, 4 rows = 1 Inch in garter stitch.

## Abbreviations:

K	Knit
P	Purl
SL	Slip stitch from left hand needle to right hand needle
YF	Yarn Forward (bring yarn to the front, between the two needles)
YB	Yarn Back (take yarn to the back, between the two needles)
RS	Right Side

# Leelee Knits

Knitting and Crochet

## Pattern:

Cast on 105 stitches (or any odd number of stitches to add width or for practice swatch) with **Color A**.

Row 1 (RS): Knit all stitches.

Row 2: Knit all stitches.

Row 3: K1, \*SL 1 Purlwise, K1;  
repeat from \* to end of row.

Row 4: K1, \*YF, SL 1 Purlwise, YB,  
K1; repeat from \* to end of row.

Row 5: Knit all stitches.

Row 6: Knit all stitches.

Row 7: K2, \*SL 1 Purlwise, K1;  
repeat from \* to last stitch, K1.

Row 8: K2, \*YF, SL 1 Purlwise, YB,  
K1; repeat from \* to last stitch, K1.



Repeat the above 8 rows until your work measures 20 inches. Switch to **Color B** and continue repeating the above 8 rows for another 20 inches. Cast off and weave in all loose ends.

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## Starry Night Baby Blanket



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# Leelee Knits

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## Supplies/Materials:

Here is what you will need to make this baby blanket:

- US 10.5/6.5 mm Straight Knitting Needles (14" long).
- 4 Skeins of [Paintbox Yarns Simply Aran Yarn](#) in Washed Teal
- Scissors.
- Tapestry/Yarn needle to weave in ends.

## Finished Size:

This blanket measures: 28" wide X 39" long (after blocking).

## Gauge:

14 stitches, 18 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch.

## Abbreviations:

K	Knit
P	Purl

# Leelee Knits

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## Pattern:

Cast on 107 stitches (or a multiple of 36 plus 19, plus 16 for border).

Knit 10 rows for bottom border in garter stitch (knit all stitches). Continue to Body of Blanket.

## **Body of Blanket:**

Row 1: K8, \*K2, P2, K11, P2, K9, P3, K7; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, K2, P2, K11, P2, K10.

Row 2: K8, \*P3, K2, P9, K2, P10, K3, P7; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, P3, K2, P9, K2, P3, K8.

Row 3: K8, \*K3, P3, K7, P3, K10, P3, K7; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, K3, P3, K7, P3, K11.

Row 4: K8, \*P4, K3, P5, K3, P12, K1, P8; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, P4, K3, P5, K3, P4, K8.

Row 5: K8, \*K4, P4, K3, P4, K12, P1, K8; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, K4, P4, K3, P4, K12.

Row 6: K8, \*P5, K4, P1, K4, P6, K2, P11, K2, P1; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, P5, K4, P1, K4, P5, K8.

Row 7: K8, \*K5, P9, K7, P2, K9, P2, K2; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, K5, P9, K13.

Row 8: K8, \*P6, K7, P8, K3, P7, K3, P2; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, P6, K7, P6, K8.

Row 9: K8, \*K6, P7, K9, P3, K5, P3, K3; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, K6, P7, K14.

Row 10: K8, \*P5, K9, P8, K4, P3, K4, P3; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, P5, K9, P5, K8.

Row 11: K8, \*K3, P13, K7, P4, K1, P4, K4; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, K3, P13, K11.

Row 12: K8, \*P1, K17, P5, K9, P4; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, P1, K17, P1, K8.

Row 13: K8, \*P19, K5, P7, K5; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, P19, K8.

Row 14: K8, \*P7, K5, P12, K7, P5; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, P7, K5, P7, K8.

Row 15: K8, \*K7, P5, K11, P9, K4; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, K7, P5, K15.

Row 16: K8, \*P8, K3, P10, K13, P2; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, P8, K3, P8, K8.

Row 17: K8, \*K8, P3, K8, P17; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, K8, P3, K16.

Row 18: K8, \*K1, P7, K3, P7, K18; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, K1, P7, K3, P7, K9.

Row 19: K8, \*K9, P1, K15, P5, K6; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, K9, P1, K17.

Row 20: K8, \*P9, K1, P15, K5, P6; repeat from \* to last 27 stitches, P9, K1, P9, K8.

# Leelee Knits

*Knitting and Crochet*

Repeat rows 1-20 until blanket measures just under 36 inches. Knit 10 more rows in garter stitch for top border.

Cast off and weave in ends.

## Sweethearts Baby Blanket



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### Supplies/Materials:

Here is what you will need to make this baby blanket:

- US7 / 4.5 mm Straight Knitting Needles (14" long).
- 4 Skeins of [Knit Picks Mighty Stitch](#) yarn in Cream.
- Scissors.
- Tapestry/Yarn needle to weave in ends.

# Leelee Knits

## Finished Size:

This blanket measures: 28" wide X 37" long.

## Gauge:

4.5 stitches, 5 rows = 1 Inch in garter stitch.

## Abbreviations:

K	Knit
P	Purl

# Leelee Knits

*Knitting and Crochet*

## Pattern:

Cast on 135 stitches (or a multiple of 12 plus 3, plus 12 for border).

Knit 8 rows for bottom border in garter stitch (knit all stitches). Continue to Body of Blanket.

 *Knitting and Crochet*

## **Body of Blanket:**

Row 1: K13, \*P1, K11; repeat from \* to last 14 stitches; P1, K13.

Row 2: K6, P7, \*K1, P11; repeat from \* to last 14 stitches; K1, P7, K6.

Row 3: K12, \*P3, K9; repeat from \* to last 15 stitches; P3, K12.

Row 4: K6, P6, \*K3, P9; repeat from \* to last 15 stitches, K3, P6, K6.

Row 5: K11, \*P5, K7; repeat from \* to last 16 stitches, P5, K11.

Row 6: K6, P5, \*K5, P7; repeat from \* to last 16 stitches, K5, P5, K6.

Row 7: K10, \*P7, K5; repeat from \* to last 17 stitches, P7, K10.

Row 8: K6, P4, \*K7, P5; repeat from \* to last 17 stitches, K7, P4, K6.

Row 9: K9, \*P9, K3; repeat from \* to last 18 stitches, P9, K9.

Row 10: K6, P3, \*K9, P3; repeat from \* to last 18 stitches, K9, P3, K6.

Row 11: K10, \*P3, K1, P3, K5; repeat from \* to last 17 stitches, P3, K1, P3, K10.

Row 12: K6, P4, \*K3, P1, K3, P5; repeat from \* to last 17 stitches, K3, P1, K3, P4, K6.

Row 13: K11, \*P1, K3, P1, K7; repeat from \* to last 16 stitches, P1, K3, P1, K11.

Row 14: K6, P to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 15: K19, \*P1, K11; repeat from \* to last 20 stitches, P1, K19.

Row 16: K6, P13, \*K1, P11; repeat from \* to last 20 stitches, K1, P13, K6.

Row 17: K18, \*P3, K9; repeat from \* to last 21 stitches, P3, K18.

Row 18: K6, P12, \*K3, P9; repeat from \* to last 21 stitches, K3, P12, K6.

Row 19: K17, \*P5, K7; repeat from \* to last 22 stitches, P5, K17.

Row 20: K6, P11, \*K5, P7; repeat from \* to last 22 stitches, K5, P11, K6.

Row 21: K16, \*P7, K5; repeat from \* to last 23 stitches, P7, K16.

Row 22: K6, P10, \*K7, P5; repeat from \* to last 23 stitches, K7, P10, K6.

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Row 23: K15, \*P9, K3; repeat from \* to last 24 stitches, P9, K15.

Row 24: K6, P9, \*K9, P3; repeat from \* to last 24 stitches, K9, P9, K6.

Row 25: K16, \*P3, K1, P3, K5; repeat from \* to last 23 stitches, P3, 1, P3, K16.

Row 26: K6, P10, \*K3, P1, K3, P5; repeat from \* to last 23 stitches, K3, P1, K3, P10, K6.

Row 27: K17, \*P1, K3, P1, K7; repeat from \* to last 22 stitches, P1, K3, P1, K17.

Row 28: K6, P to last 6 stitches, K6.

Repeat rows 1-28 until blanket measures just under 36 inches. Knit 8 more rows in garter stitch for top border.

Cast off and weave in ends.

## Supplies/Materials:

Here is what you will need to make this baby blanket:

- US 10.5/6.5 mm Straight Knitting Needles (14" long).
- 5 Skeins of [Berroco Comfort Chunky Weight Yarn](#) in Boy Blue.
- Scissors.
- Tapestry/Yarn needle to weave in ends.

## Finished Size:

This blanket measures: 27" wide X 32" long.

## Gauge:

3.75 stitches, 4 rows = 1 Inch in stockinette stitch.

## Abbreviations:

K	Knit
P	Purl

# Leelee Knits

*Knitting and Crochet*

## Pattern:

Cast on 112 stitches. Continue to Bottom Border.

### **Bottom Border:**

Rows 1-6: Knit all stitches (garter stitch). Continue to Body of Blanket.

## **Body of Blanket:**

Row 1: K10; \*P2, K4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 2: K6; P4; \*K2, P4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 3: K10; \*P2, K4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 4: K6; P4; \*K2, P4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 5: K10; \*P2, K4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 6: K6; P4; \*K2, P4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 7: K6; P4; \*K2, P4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 8: K10; \*P2, K4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Repeat rows 1-8 until blanket measures just under 30 inches. Continue to Top Border.

## **Top Border:**

Row 1: K10; \*P2, K4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 2: K6; P4; \*K2, P4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 3: K10; \*P2, K4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 4: K6; P4; \*K2, P4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 5: K10; \*P2, K4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 6: K6; P4; \*K2, P4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, K6.

Rows 7-12: Knit all stitches (garter stitch).

Cast off and weave in all loose ends.

## Country Bliss Baby Blanket



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## Materials:

Here is what you will need to make this baby blanket:

- US 13 (or 9 mm) Knitting Needles.
- Cable Needle.
- 7 Skeins of Paintbox Yarns Simply Chunky Yarn in Stormy Grey
- Scissors.
- Tapestry/Yarn needle to weave in ends.

## Measurements:

Finished blanket measures 31" X 44".

## Gauge:

4 rows, 3.5 stitches = 1 inch in stockinette stitch.

## Abbreviations:

K	Knit
P	Purl
C8F	Cable 8 Front (slip 4 stitches onto your cable needle to the front of your work, knit the next 4 stitches, then knit the 4 stitches off of the cable needle).
C8B	Cable 8 Back (slip 4 stitches onto your cable needle to the back of your work, knit the next 4 stitches, then knit the 4 stitches off of the cable needle).

## Pattern:

Cast on 124 Stitches.

Row 1-6: \*K2, P2; repeat from \* to end of the row (for bottom border).

Row 7: K8; \*K12, P2, K16, P2; repeat from \* two more times; K20.

Row 8: K8, \*P12, K2, P16, K2; repeat from \* two more times; P12, K8.

Row 9: K8; \*K12, P2, C8B, C8F, P2; repeat from \* two more times; K20.

Row 10: K8, \*P12, K2, P16, K2; repeat from \* two more times; P12, K8.

Row 11: K8; \*K12, P2, K16, P2; repeat from \* two more times; K20.

Row 12: K8, \*P12, K2, P16, K2; repeat from \* two more times; P12, K8.

Row 13: K8; \*K12, P2, K16, P2; repeat from \* two more times; K20.

Row 14: K8, \*P12, K2, P16, K2; repeat from \* two more times; P12, K8.

Repeat rows 7-14 until work measures 42.5 inches.

Repeat rows 1-6 to complete top border.

## Finishing:

Cast off and weave in the loose ends with a yarn needle.
