

Beginner Knit Shawl



Materials:

- [Paintbox Yarns Simply Chunky 100% Acrylic Yarn:](#)
 - 4 Skeins Vanilla Cream (color A).
 - 2 Skeins Pure Black (color B).
- Size 13 (9 mm) 32" or longer circular knitting needles.
- 2 Stitch Markers.
- Scissors.
- Yarn needle for weaving in ends.

Gauge:

15 stitches, 18 rows = 4 inches in garter stitch.

Size:

81" wide (side to side) X 23" long (top to bottom).

Abbreviations:

K: Knit.

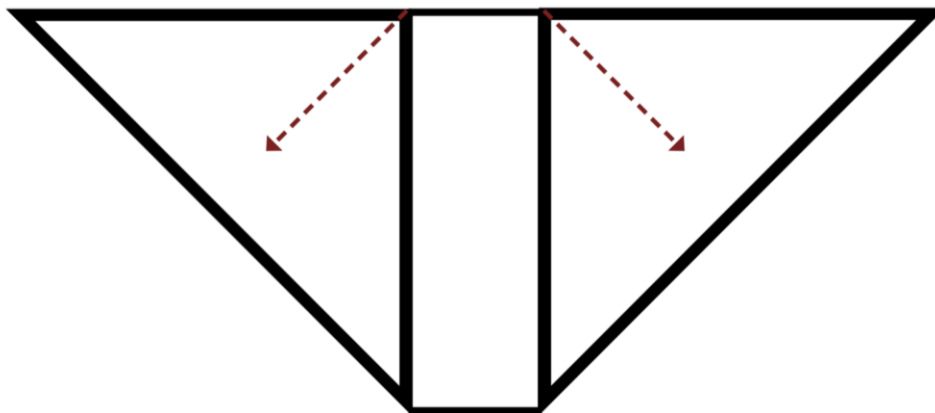
P: Purl.

KFB: Knit in the front and back of the stitch (increase).

PM: Place stitch marker.

Notes:

This shawl is worked entirely in garter stitch from the top down with a center spine of 15 stitches. The increases are made so that the width will grow as two triangles along both sides of the center spine.



Leelee Knits

Knitting and Crochet

Pattern:

Cast on 25 stitches with Color A (long tail cast on).

Row 1: K2, KFB, K1, KFB, PM, K15, PM, KFB, K1, KFB, K2 (you will have increased by 4 stitches – see Image A on next page for what your work should look like).

Row 2: Knit all stitches.

Row 3: K2, KFB, Knit to last stitch before first marker, KFB, K15, KFB, Knit to last 3 stitches, KFB, K2 (see Image B on next page for where KFB increases are made).

Row 4: Knit all stitches.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 switching colors according to Color Scheme below. Once all rows have been knit, cast off and weave in all loose ends.

Color Scheme:

24 Rows Color A

16 Rows Color B

34 Rows Color A

16 Rows Color B

24 Rows Color A
