

Creamy Cables Knit Throw



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Leelee Knits

 Knitting and Crochet

Materials

Here is what you will need to make this cozy cabled throw:

- US Size 13 (9.0 mm) 32" Circular Knitting Needles.
- [Paintbox Yarns Simply Chunky Yarn:](#)
 - 5 Skeins Vanilla Cream (Color A).
 - 5 Skeins Champagne White (Color B).
- Cable Hook.
- Scissors.
- Crochet Hook for attaching tassels (optional).
- Tapestry/Yarn needle to weave in ends.

Measurements:

Throw Measures 37" wide X 56" long.

Abbreviations:

K: Knit

P: Purl

C14B: Cable 14 Back. Slip 7 stitches onto your cable hook (hold cable hook to the back of your work), knit the next 7 stitches, and then knit the 7 stitches off of the cable hook.

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Pattern:

With color A, cast on 132 stitches:

Rows 1,3,5,7,9,11,13,15,17,19: K3, P6, *K14, P6; repeat from * to last 3 stitches, K3.

Rows 2,4,6,8,10,12,14,16,18,20: P3, K6 *P14, K6; repeat from * to last 3 stitches, P3.

Row 21: K3, P6, *C14B, P6; repeat from * to last 3 stitches, K3.

Row 22: P3, K6 *P14, K6; repeat from * to last 3 stitches, P3.

Repeat rows 1-22 four more times.

Switch to color B and repeat rows 1-22 four times.

Repeat rows 1-20 once more with color B.

Continue to Finishing.



Finishing:

Cast off in pattern and weave in all loose ends.

Create 8 tassels in each colour and attach them evenly spaced to the blanket ends (one in each corner and then one halfway through each row of cables).

To make the tassels, wrap yarn around a 6 inch long piece of cardboard ten times. Thread a strand of yarn through the top and secure with a knot (A). Snip through the ends at the bottom and tie another piece of yarn around the top approximately half an inch down (B). Trim the ends so that they are even. Use a crochet hook or yarn needle to pull yarn through the edge of the blanket and tie in a knot to secure the tassel. Weave in the ends.
